About you:

About the role:

Your role will be to clean the premises from including our toilets, lobby, offices, meeting rooms, restaurant, café and shop areas (carpeted, polished concrete and hardwood floors) ensuring that the working and customer areas and all equipment and furniture is cleaned to the highest standards following the correct cleaning procedures to maintain good hygiene and health and safety standards, adhering to regulations with regard to the use and storage of chemicals. During our busy periods, you may also be required support service, cleaning spills, clearing tables and helping potwash in the kitchen, so we can continue to maximise the throughput of guests across site and maintain exceptional levels of cleanliness at all times.

Due to the nature of the role and the requirement to sometimes work alone, applicants need to be a minimum of 16 years old. About the contract:

These roles can offer regular weekly working hours to suit on part-time hours with potential to work more hours in our busy periods (typically during school holidays).
